The **European Platform** is a network of non-governmental organisations, researchers, intellectuals and experts who share the goal of raising awareness on the problem of intolerance and discrimination against Christians in Europe, as a first step towards a remedy and the basis for concrete action.

The European Platform supports the raising awareness by data collection, analysis, publications and engagement with the media and governmental institutions.

VISION

The Platform is a network of information. Full and associate members are invited to submit their findings to the Observatory. The Observatory provides its partners timely with its data. The networks members are invited to pass on the Observatory's results in their area of work. The Observatory engages the network members in the development of its main strategies and focusses.

The Platform is a network of exchange. All members are invited to thematic seminars as well as a annual network meetings resulting in common awareness and a common agenda, which is crucial to success. The participation in these events is optional and free of charge for network members.

The Platform is a network of coordinated efforts. All members are able to be in contact with one another via the network. The Observatory aims at providing and facilitating easy access to information on related international developments and meetings.
